AUPO FCC

The AUPO FCC, a Limited Liability Corporation, is a non-profit professional medical organization committed to the establishment of ophthalmology training standards in fellowship programs. The AUPO FCC offers a compliance system focused on uniform educational standards, protection of the public, protection of institutions, protection of trainees, accountability and enforcement. The compliance process is voluntary and financed by participating fellowship programs, subspecialty societies, Fellowship Central Application Service (SF MATCH CAS) and the AUPO. All subspecialties in ophthalmology are encouraged to participate in the AUPO FCC.



GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE AUPO FELLOWSHIP COMPLIANCE COMMITTEE (AUPO FCC)

GOALS

To provide a system that will enhance patient care for ophthalmology diseases by promoting uniform standards for fellowship training and educational programs in the following ophthalmic subspecialties: cornea, external disease & refractive surgery; glaucoma; neuro-ophthalmology; pathology/ocular oncology; pediatric ophthalmology; surgical retina and uveitis.

OBJECTIVES

1. The Fellowship Compliance Committee in conjunction with each subspecialty society will establish a format and standards for the subspecialties in establishing program requirements.
2. Each participating subspecialty through the action of its professional society will define a set of criteria for its own subspecialty, constituting standards for fellowship training to include curriculum as well as research and clinical experience.
3. The Fellowship Compliance Committee will help to coordinate the establishment of fellowship program requirements and monitor compliance of individual fellowship programs with these requirements.
4. The Fellowship Compliance Committee will make determinations of the compliance of initial applications of individual fellowship programs for inclusion in the compliance program.
5. Programs admitted to the compliance program will be monitored annually based on a fellow exit survey and also on a triennial or quadrennial program review basis to assure that they remain in compliance.
6. Application and compliance monitoring will be accomplished through a web-based system.
7. Compliance status will be made publicly available so that fellowship applicants may use this information in their decision.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE AUPO FCC SUBSPECIALTY REPRESENTATIVES

Each participating subspecialty society has two representatives*. One of the representatives is designated as the primary representative and serves on the Review Committee of the FCC. The other representative assists the primary representative as needed and provides additional support to the subspecialty review processes, including ongoing reviews and updates to the program requirements. Each subspecialty has two voting members on the Board of Managers. One exception to this is Surgical Retina which has 3 voting members representing 3 Retina related societies.

As outlined below, there are three main components to the Subspecialty Representative duties:

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Review applications and supporting materials.
- Recommend compliance, request additional information when needed, or in the case of a program not meeting the requirements, recommend that a program not be granted compliant status.
- Submit recommendations to the full FCC Review Committee, on which one of the representatives serves as a voting member.

FELLOW EXIT SURVEY PROCESS

- Review the surveys submitted.
- Initiate a response to fellowship directors requesting more information when a potential deficiency is identified.
- Recommend continued compliance or non-compliance.

TRIENNIAL/QUADRENNIAL REVIEW PROCESS

- Identify the compliant programs that are due for their triennial or quadrennial review.
- Review program documentation covering the three or four year period.
- Recommend continued compliance or non-compliance.

ADDITIONAL DUTIES

- Attend 2 meetings per year.
- Report at each of the meetings.
- Make critical decisions about the compliance program and process.

* Note: Retina represents three societies; therefore, there are three representatives.
