Fine Print

- Institutions may have more than one program that differ by special applicant requirements (e.g. neuro vs. ophth residency training)
- The participating programs agree not to make any appointments prior to the match (except those filled prior to June 4, 2022)
- Statements of intent must be unilateral, voluntary, and unconditional. Neither party may ask the other for a commitment.
- Both parties are bound by the results of the match. However, an applicant's actual entry into the training program (and continuation in it) is contingent upon satisfactory completion of the prerequisite training, any special requirements the program may have stated explicitly for all applicants, and satisfactory performance during training.
