What to Flag

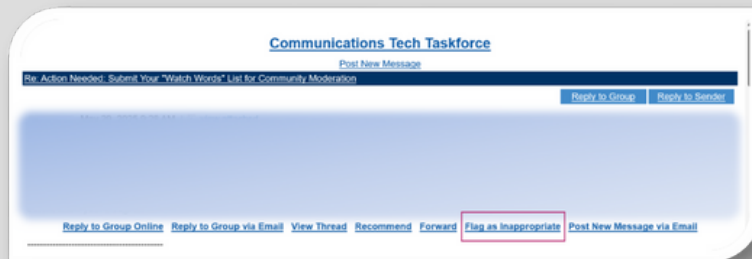
- **Patient-Identifying Information:** Maintain confidentiality (HIPAA compliance).
- **Antitrust Compliance:** Avoid discussing fees, prices, or market allocations.
- **Commercial Messages:** Without prior approval.
- **Copyrighted Material:** Without permission.
- **Defamatory Content:** Abusive or offensive.

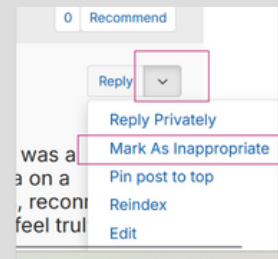
Step-by-step guide on how to flag content:

Flag Inappropriate Content

- If you see a post that seems inappropriate, click “Mark as Inappropriate” on the community page or directly from the email notification.

Provide a Reason

- You'll be prompted to briefly explain why the content is being flagged. This helps ensure transparency and thoughtful moderation.

What Happens Next

- The content is temporarily removed and sent to the **Community Moderator**, who will:
 - **Approve** the moderation request to keep it hidden, or
 - **Reject** it, restoring the content to the thread.
